SPEAKER BIOGRAPHIES

DEAN CHUANG (pronounced “Chwong”) is a Spokane criminal defense attorney serving those accused of crimes in Washington State. He was trained by the late John R. Clark in all aspects of criminal defense. Dean specializes in traffic infractions and crimes, DUI defense, and other state and local Spokane criminal defense matters. He also litigates Department of Licensing hearings, Washington State Liquor Control Board violations and University disciplinary hearings. Dean is a partner and head of the criminal law section of Crary, Clark & Domanico, P.S. in Spokane, Washington. He has been an attorney since 2006 and is a member of the Washington State and Spokane County Bar Associations, the National College for DUI Defense, the Washington Defender Association, and sits on the Board of Governors of the Washington Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers.

Dean was born in Walla Walla, Washington, and was raised in Tumwater, Washington. He received his undergraduate degree in biology from Whitman College in 2002, and a second undergraduate degree in general studies from the University of Washington in 2003. Dean graduated from Gonzaga University School of Law in 2006, where he was awarded an Army ROTC scholarship. He currently serves part-time in the Washington Army National Guard as a staff officer. After law school, Dean worked as a public defender in Benton County until he joined the firm of Crary, Clark, Domanico & Chuang, P.S., in 2008.

Dean has appeared on Fox and Friends, CNN, Good Morning America, Associated Press, Wall Street Journal, National Public Radio, Spokesman Review, as well as various local news outlets.

DEANNA K. CRULL - Arriving in Spokane to go to Gonzaga University was just the first step in my dream of becoming a lawyer. Gonzaga School of Law was the next. After graduation, I gained invaluable experience as a prosecutor before going into private practice. After a few years working for one of Spokane’s best criminal defense firms, I opened Action Legal Group, PLLC. Officer Yen has spent 5 years on patrol working various shift times (Day Shift, Swing Shift, Power Shift, and Graveyard Shift). Officer Yen is currently assigned to the Traffic Unit and works as a DUI Enforcement Officer for the City Of Spokane. Officer Yen works on the TZT DUI Patrol team for DUI Emphasis. Officer Yen is a certified Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) and is a Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST's) Instructor. Officer J. Yen has taught classes related to SFST's around the state of Washington and Hawaii.
