Effective August 1, 2020 and pursuant to the intent of GR 30(b)(4), electronic filing through the Court of Appeals' e-filing Internet portal is mandatory for any case participant who is admitted to practice law in the State of Washington, and,

Effective August 1, 2020 the Appellate Electronic Court Record is hereby designated as the official court record of the Court of Appeals and no hard copy paper case files will be created or maintained GR 30(d)(3).
